

# Silver Clay Jewellery Ideas For Beginners

A visual guide on how to make silver clay jewellery

Perfect if you're just getting started in jewellery making, silver clay is simple to use and beautifully intricate.

So, if you're wondering how to make silver clay jewellery, use our guide to find out how you can make some of our top silver clay jewellery ideas.

## Fingerprint Pendants

- 1 Roll the PMC on a flat surface
- 2 With a clean finger, push into the clay considering where you want the design to be
- 3 Gently roll your finger from side to side to ensure all the fingerprint has imprinted
- 4 Cut around the design, leave to dry and then start the firing process
- 5 Once fired, use a brass brush and then polish to finish



## Silver Clay Ring

- 1 Use a ring sizer to measure the amount of clay needed and add 15%
- 2 Roll out the clay and add texture if desired
- 3 Cut the clay to shape with a sharp blade
- 4 Leave to dry for 24 hours, then sandpaper the edges to smoothen
- 5 Begin the firing process then brush and polish
- 6 Next, shape the ring with pliers then use a mandrel and mallet to connect together

### Top tip

PMC shrinks 10-15% during firing, so account for this when calculating the amount of clay you need.



## Adding texture to silver clay jewellery
